◆ RESERVED EASEMENTS:

EIN 7a

An existing trail running southerly and easterly from Dry Spruce Bay to Settler Cove. (25-foot trail)

EIN 8

An existing trail west and south of Kizhuyak Bay. (25-foot trail)

EIN 11

An existing trail from Fox Bay to Marmot Bay (local name). (25-foot trail)

EIN 14

A proposed trail from the shore of Barabara Cove at site EIN 42 southwesterly along the right bank of Barabara Creek (local name) to Barabara Lake (local name) and continuing westerly. (25-foot trail)

EIN 14a

A proposed trail from the head of Sharatin Bay southerly along the left bank of Elbow Creek. (25-foot trail)

EIN 22

A proposed trail running westerly from Anton Larsen Road to the shore of Sharatin Bay at site EIN 22a near Three Pillar Point. (25-foot trail)

EIN 22a

A campsite on the east shore of Sharatin Bay near Three Pillar Point. (one-acre site)

EIN 26

A proposed trail running southwesterly from the shore of Whale Passage. (25-foot trail)

EIN 28

A proposed trail running westerly from Settler Cove near the Port Lions airstrip. (25-foot trail)

EIN 38

A proposed trail running westerly from the shore of Kizhuyak Bay at site EIN 43. (25-foot trail)

EIN 42

A campsite on the shore of Barabara Cove. (one-acre site) Easement to be donated after appeal settled

EIN 43

A campsite on the shore Kizhuyak Bay near the mouth of an unnamed creek. (one-acre site) Easement to be donated after appeal settled


EIN 44
