Public Notice Alert Sign-Up Instructions

- * Navigate your internet browser to the following link:
<http://aws.state.ak.us/OnlinePublicNotices/> and scroll to the bottom of the page
- * Under the 'New Features' heading you will find 'Subscriptions.' You can select to view all notices by clicking on the RSS, or receive by email (envelope symbol) 'All notices' link.
- * If you would like to filter the notices you receive, click on the 'Search Now' link to build a custom subscription. You can change the fields on the search page to filter the notifications you receive.
 - o You can search by 'status'; whether the file is active or archived (in storage)
 - o You can enter keywords, such as "land Use Permit," in the 'title' or 'full text' fields, to specify which type of notices you want
 - o You can pick a certain department, category and/or subcategory
 - o You can receive updates on a single file if you have the project number
 - o You can change the dates so you only receive notices posted within a certain period of time
- * Click the 'Search' button when you have finished customizing your query to see the populated results. You can change any boxes and refresh by pressing the 'Search' button again.
- * When the results are to your liking, click on the word 'Subscribe' in the grey bar located below the 'Search' button; this will bring up a pop-up box with a list of links.
- * To receive your customized notifications, click on link with the envelope that says 'To Search Criteria' and then enter your email address.


- 6) In what ways could the bigger area events be managed to further minimize undesired local impact and maximize local benefit?
