**Average snow depth recorded is uncompressed. Snowmobile openings are based on the snowpack's ability to protect underlying vegetation and include: depth measurements, snow density, wind loading, temperatures, forecast, terrain, topography, elevation, and snow base and ice conditions. River and lake *ice crossing safety is not implied* and at the risk of the individual. Conditions update:

The Nancy Lake Parkway will be plowed on Monday April 15 &16 use alternative routes to avoid machinery.

Snowmachine closeure will likely be the next Sunday, April 21. Call ahead for updates 495-6212.

Daytime temps have been well above freezing with cooler temperatures overnight. Use caution as overflow exists off packed trails, especially Lynx Lake, (north end) and Red Shirt Lake.

Reminder that highway vehicles are prohibited beyond the winter trailhead/Nancy Lake Pkwy. mile 2.2. Snowmachines, skiers, dog mushers, and fat tire bikers are welcome beyond this point.

Give moose the right of way.

A \$5 day-use fee or annual parking pass is required at most trailheads throughout the park. Please respect private properties adjacent to park land. All snowmobiles must have their current registration tags displayed when used on public lands.
